Next General Membership Meeting

Crime Watch Update

Pat and Richard reported on their recently held block captain front yard events. Pat's meeting was held in the yard of Darrel Alsup.

A discussion of the recent wave of break-ins and vandalism was discussed.

The board members took an action to clarify the role of crime watch coordinator and to see if the crime watch needs to register with the GPD.

Board Makeup

The board discussed adding two additional at-large board members to bring more neighborhood diversity to the board; Judi Lazerus and Maud Taylor where discussed as candidates. They would need to be voted on at a general membership meeting. Pat Cruse is to contact Judi and Maud to see if they will serve. Email List

Jim raised the issue of a second mailing list for general neighborhood information and keeping the current list for reporting crime watch information. It seems like the current list is only used to report neighborhood crimes. It was decided that maintaining multiple lists created more administration overhead. Only one list will be maintained. Instead, emails will go out with informative tags at the start of the subject (e.g. Crime Watch, Info, Meeting)

New Committees

Pat Cruse raised the issue of starting some new committees. A national night out committee needs to be formed now to begin organizing the October national night out block party. It was suggested forming a second committee on neighborhood infrastructure to address issue such as getting a wall built between the shopping center and the northern neighborhood boundary and getting better street lights. A third committee on neighborhood beautification was suggested to maintain the appearance of the neighborhood boundary wall and to run a yard of the month program.
