We will try to find a closer color match, when we meet with the contractor.

Treasurer Rex Gifford reported that over \$17,000 has been raised for our wall project. The total amount in the MENA account is \$21,000.

An announcement was made that we will vote on a change to our bylaws at our next meeting. Two current board members have served two consecutive terms in office. Since nobody else wants to become a board member, we need to remove the term limits. This will allow the current members to continue serving until we finish this wall project.

A resident inquired about being included in the project. After discussion, he decided he could not make a donation at this time, but would like to participate in possible future wall repair projects.
