

Minutes from general meeting of MENA, at North Garland Library, June 8, 2017.

Meeting called to order by Michael Rideau at 7:04 p.m.

Discussion about wall repair costs, curb repair costs, and street light replacement. Call Onco for street light replacement. Phone numbers are on our website.

Code Enforcement officers are helpful for many problems. They will usually work with the homeowner, if they see an attempt is being made to remedy the problem.

The landscaping at the Rochdale entrance is not being maintained. The overgrown plants are creating a dangerous situation for drivers coming out of Rochdale onto Beltline. Several board members volunteered to do a one-time cleanup of this entrance. Darrell Alsup will talk to the two homeowners, to get permission for us to work on their property. A work day will be scheduled sometime in June.
